Iraq Veteran & Pacific Records recording artist John Preston honors fellow Marine on his one-year anniversary of his death: Releasing new EP "Day to Night" & music video telling the story of war hero Sergeant Charles Strong

Iraq veteran singer songwriter John Preston is now releasing his new Ep "Day to Night" featuring a new music video honoring fellow Marine, Sergeant Charles Strong that was just killed in action last year in Afghanistan on his last day in country. His wife, Taylor, was eight months pregnant when he was killed. She actually came out and played herself in the video and 30 % of the album proceeds will be going to her and her baby Sophie. The release date is on the one-year anniversary of Sergeant Strong's death.

"Though I didn't personally know Charles we had a common friend and I knew the day he died that it happened. I didn't write the song until March 15, six months after Charles's passing and it was like my words and hands were guided because when I sat down at the piano I had no intention of telling this story, it just came out"-John Preston

Since the release of John's first LA Music Award nominated EP "Your War is Over" in November of last year John done media all over the country raising awareness to the 22 veteran suicides a day and has done all he can to raise awareness and money for veterans that battle with PTSD. 30% of the sales of that EP are being donated to The Boot Campaign to directly fight PTSD. John is a rising artist with a mission and plans to take his career to the next level with his release of "Day to Night"
